What personal data we collect and why we collect it

Mindset for Success ABN 607 667 61712 is committed to protecting the information about you that we collect, store and use when you provide it to us on our website: <https://mindsetforsuccess.com.au> (Site).

We manage your information in accordance with the requirements of the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) and the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

By accessing the Site, registering for our products and services, or entering your details on via 'contact us', you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information in accordance with this.

Personal information collection and use

Mandy Napier collects personally identifiable information about you, being:

- 1 Your name
- 2 Your contact information including email address
- 3 Demographic information including postcode when you purchase a product
- 4 Your payment details

What we do with your personal information

We collect, hold and use your personal information for the following reasons:

1. Assist us in providing services to you
2. Contact you or respond to your queries

3. Tailor your experience of the Site and our communications to you
4. To advertise our services and the Site
5. For our internal administrative, marketing and planning requirements
6. To compile and report statistics, with all the relevant personal and/or proprietary information de-identified prior to the completion of such statistics
7. For purposes that are expressly permitted under any agreement with you.

To whom will Mandy Napier disclose my personal information?

We do not disclose personal information about you publicly or to third parties unless it is authorised or required by law, or as otherwise outlined in this Privacy Policy.

From time to time, we may disclose your personal information (on a confidential basis) to agents and others that we use in the ordinary operation of our business, marketing and promotion, user experience research and surveys, Site hosting and support and maintenance. We will only disclose your information to the extent required for the purpose of the third party providing services contracted to us so that we may serve you.

Your personal information will never be sold to any third party.

Comments

When visitors leave comments on the site we collect the data shown in the comments form, and also the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to help spam detection.

An anonymised string created from your email address (also called a hash) may be provided to the Gravatar service to see if you are using it. The Gravatar service privacy policy is available [here](#):

<https://automattic.com/privacy/>. After approval of your comment, your profile picture is visible to the public in the context of your comment.

Media

If you upload images to the website, you should avoid uploading images with embedded location data (EXIF GPS) included. Visitors to the website can download and extract any location data from images on the website.

Cookies

If you leave a comment on our site you may opt-in to saving your name, email address and website in cookies. These are for your convenience so that you do not have to fill in your details again when you leave another comment. These cookies will last for one year.

If you visit our login page, we will set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser.

When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for a year. If you select "Remember Me", your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie will be saved in your browser. This cookie includes no personal data and simply indicates the post ID of the article you just edited. It expires after 1 day.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

Site User Experience Tracking
